


Findings.

Bridge Course Report

In order to test the aptitude of the newly admitted students with regard to their adaptability to the undergraduate syllabus, a bridge course was conducted by the department from 12th to 20th September 2022. The course consisted of seven lectures on the basics of political science which would facilitate the students from high school to adapt to the University of Kalyani Political Science honours CBCS syllabus. The faculty members of the department were the resource persons. Twenty newly admitted students participated in this course. After the lectures, an MCQ test was held based on the contents of the lecture. The marks obtained in this test helped the department categorise the participating students into three categories- advanced learners, average learners and slow learners. There were twenty MCQs. Students scoring fifteen or above have been classified as advanced learner. Those scoring between eight to fourteen have been classified as average learners. Those receiving seven or less have been identified as slow learners.

Bridge Course Report

From November 14, 2022, the department of Sanskrit organised a bridge course to assess the newly admitted students' aptitude in terms of their ability to adjust to the undergraduate curriculum. Six lectures covering the fundamentals of Sanskrit were included in the course to help high school students acclimatize to the University of Kalyani's Sanskrit Honours CBCS program. The department's faculty members served as the resource persons. In this bridge course, twenty freshly admitted students participated. Following the lectures, there was an MCQ test based on the materials covered. The department adjudged the participating students into three groups based on their test scores: advanced learners (scoring 15 or above), average learners (8-14), and slow learners (scoring 7 or less).
